AUSTIN CAMPUS EXPANSION

The Austin Campus construction project is officially underway. After the 10:30 a.m. service on October 15, the Epiphany family participated in a ground breaking ceremony where the addition will be located.

On Monday, October 16, our construction partner, R L Fender Construction, began demolition and prep-work for the addition. Brick and siding were removed from the portion of the building where the new addition will tie in. Concrete footers were also poured for the addition and for the new garage that is part of the project. Furthermore, the Sanctuary will take on an "under construction" feel during the interior project work, and the worship space is reconfigured. While it will be a few months until our beautiful new sanctuary is complete, it should be fun to come in each Sunday to see the progress unfold.

FAR HILLS MAINTENANCE

Two additional drains have been added to the upper parking lot. One drain is located in an area where we normally have water and ice build-up in the winter. The second drain is located at the top of the stairs from the parking lot down to the main south entrance. This improvement was originally scheduled for the end of the 2017 Capital Appeal. However, winter safety concerns led to a decision to use existing building maintenance funds in October 2017 to complete this improvement.
