1. Why did the kids interview people in their congregation?
 2. What happened when Victor realized he had forgotten the assignment?
 3. Where did Myrtle, the organist, learn about Jesus?
 4. Which story surprised you most?
 5. If you could interview Jesus, what would you ask?
 6. Who would you interview?
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Bible Story: Woman at the Well

Read John 4:5-42 together, then ask the following questions:

1. Why was Jesus at the well?
 2. Whom did Jesus ask for water?
 3. What kind of water did Jesus say he could give the woman?
 4. How did the woman respond to the things that Jesus said?
 5. In Jesus' time, Jewish people and Samaritans did not get along. How can people today get along with each other?
 6. What do you think living water is?

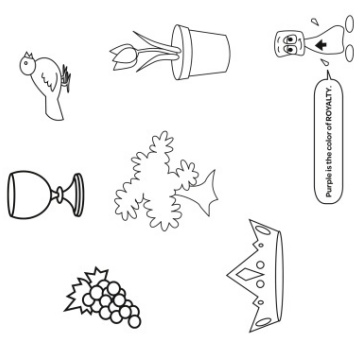

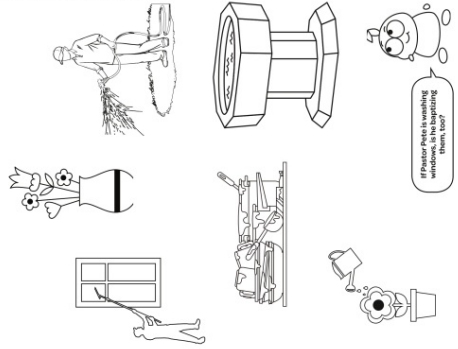
