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PROJECT (CHOOSE ONE)

OPTION ONE: WRITE

Read Luther's explanations of The Sacrament of Holy Baptism (Lutheran Handbook pp. 214-216 or The Sacrament of Holy Communion (Lutheran Handbook pp. 222-223). Then, write a 1-2 paragraph response to the question: What does (Baptism/Communion) mean to me? Use some of the discussion questions above to get started. Turn in your response to Erin.

Choosing either Baptism or Communion, create a visual representation (drawing, painting, sculpture, etc.) of what that sacrament means to you. Write a short 3-4 sentence reflection. Turn both in to Erin.
